Call Meeting to Order

Trustee Miller stated the special meeting of the Perry Township Board of Trustees is called to order at 5:00 pm for a special meeting.

Discussion of Road Paving:

The discussion was had with the Public Works Director and Chris from the Road Department regarding what they could do to assist with the longevity of the roads and if chip and seal was an option as the road levy did not pass. The Township needs to find ways to assist with the roads cost-effectively and only pave the main roads. Chris explained what chip and seal were to the Board and explained they use this method on some of the highways. The number of roads set to be paved is 6.7 miles and will decline since the levy did not pass.

A discussion was had on the process of sending a notice out to begin receiving bids for the road paving. That would be around 6 or 7 roads for the Township this year. We will bid out less than 4.5 miles and Canton City will have 2.3 miles that we will have to pay for.
